ARCHITECTURE	a term to describe buildings and other structures. The art and style of design and method of construction of buildings and other physical structures.
THE SISTINE CHAPEL	it is famous for its Renaissance wall paintings by Michelangelo. The Creation of Adam, detail of the ceiling by Michelangelo, 1508–12; in the Sistine Chapel, Vatican City.
DANTE'S INFERNO	Inferno is the first part of Italian writer Dante Alighieri's 14th-century epic poem that you are learning about in English.
St. BASIL'S CATHEDRAL	Saint Basil's Cathedral is an Orthodox church in Red Square of Moscow. Opening in 1561, it is one of the most popular cultural symbols of Russia.
THE CATHEDRAL OF NOTRE DAME	Notre-Dame Cathedral is the most famous of the Gothic cathedrals of the Middle Ages and is distinguished for its size, architectural interest and gargoyles.

What is the 'Renaissance'?

The Renaissance is a term used to describe a period in European history marking the transition from the Middle Ages.

The Renaissance was a cultural movement that profoundly affected European life in the early modern period

Beginning in Italy and spreading to the rest of Europe by the 16th century, its influence was felt in art, architecture, philosophy, literature, music, science, technology, politics and religion.

Renaissance scholars searched for realism and human emotion in art.

The 'pinch pot'.

A ceramic technique to create a rounded, hollow shell which can be used to mould a gargoyle.
