
## Key Vocabulary... **GRAPHIC ART** is the type of fine art that covers a broad range of visual expression that is usually 2-dimensional i.e on a flat surface. It is made up of a range of graphic techniques such as line drawings, mark-making and digital imagery using line and tone rather than the use of colour. LINE DRAWING is a drawing created using only narrow lines and of differing clusters to create depth and tone without using blocks of colour. MARK-MAKING is a term used to describe the creation of pattern, lines, textures and shapes. Always remember... FREELANCE Working on a freel basis is when someone is self-employed and hired to work for different companies or individuals and work is tailored to their individual needs and wants. ILLUSTRATOR The job of an illustrator is to draw or create images for children's books, advertising or magazines.
