

## Key Vocabulary...

<b>GRAPHIC ART</b>	is the type of fine art that covers a broad range of visual expression that is usually 2-dimensional i.e. on a flat surface. It is made up of a range of graphic techniques such as line drawings, mark-making and digital imagery using line and tone rather than the use of colour.
<b>LINE DRAWING</b>	is a drawing created using only narrow lines and of differing clusters to create depth and tone without using blocks of colour.
<b>MARK-MAKING</b>	is a term used to describe the creation of <b>pattern, lines, textures</b> and <b>shapes</b> .

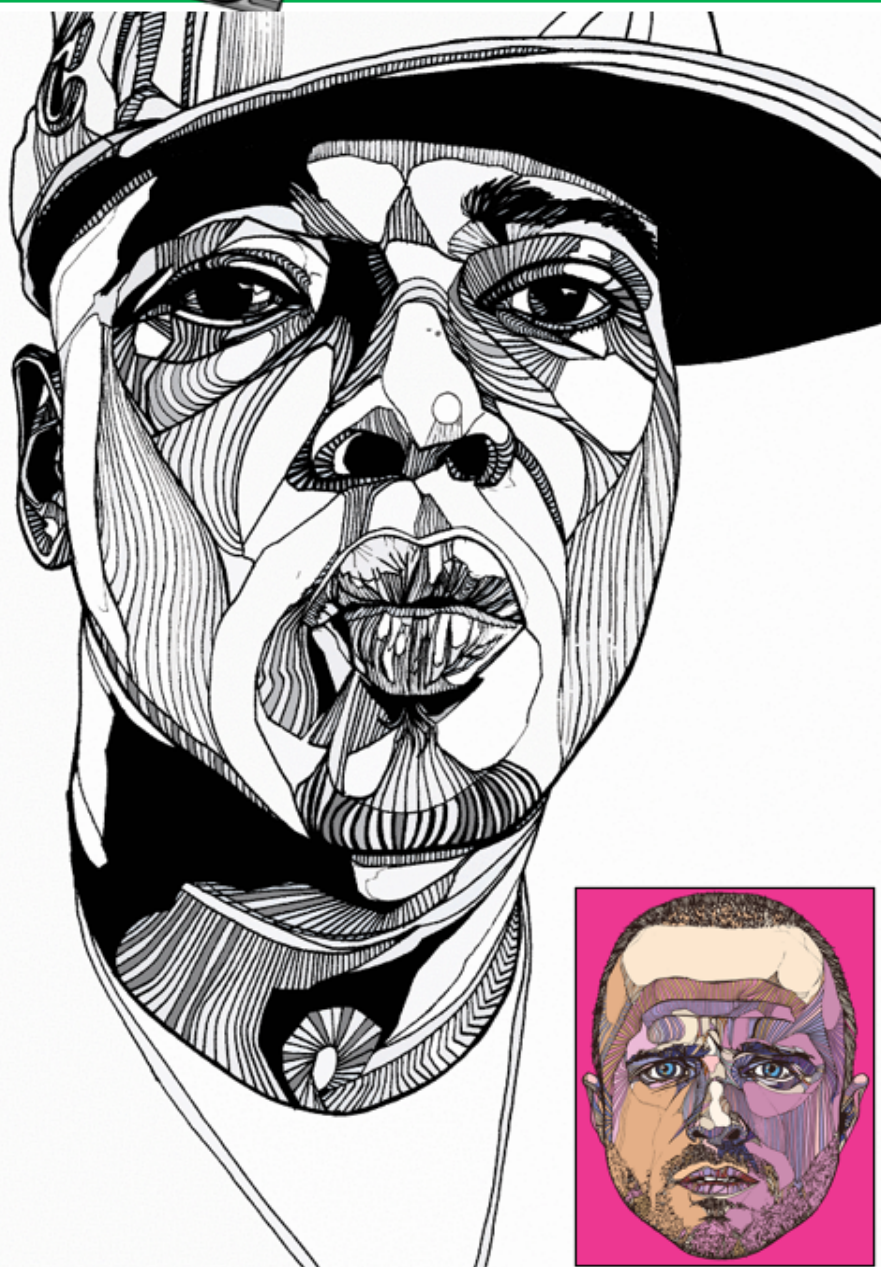
## Always remember...
